- 3. Submit a photo or a scanned copy of your artwork, along with your name, scout group and section to safeguarding@scoutfoundationni.org.uk

The closing date for the competition is Sunday, 30th August 2020.

Two winning designs will be chosen: one for Beaver/Cubs and one for Scouts/Ventures/Rovers.

The 2 winning designs will be recreated by a graphic designer and copies will be professionally printed. Copies of the posters will be delivered to all local scout groups in the Northern province for display in scout halls when we return to scouting indoors.

Tips

- The winning poster will be on display in your scout hall, so it needs to be easy to read and understand from a distance.
- Use colours, images, illustrations. These must stand out.
- Include a clear call to action
