




Funding Scheme for Regional and Local Voluntary Youth Organisations

Contained within this booklet is key information to support organisations who wish to make an application for Generic Non-Targeted Funding in 2022-2023, including information to register for the first time or complete annual reregistration

What is Generic/Non-Targeted Funding?



Voluntary Youth programmes delivered solely by Volunteers

All Education Authority registered youth organisations whose youth work is delivered by volunteers for example, uniformed organisations, church-based organisations, with young people aged 4-25 years.



Funding is Allocated Each Year Through Annual Application

Funding is for one year and applications will be publicly advertised annually on the EA Funding website. The level of funding available will be based on the hours of programme delivered average attendance of young people

Introduction to Applying in 2022-2023

For Generic Non-Targeted Funding



Registration and Application Process 2022-2023

STEP	What You Need to Do
1	Complete your annual re-registration or register for the first time with the Education Authority
2	If you are currently in receipt of Generic/Non-Target Funding for 2021-2022, complete your annual report on the funding portal first. If you are a NEW organisation you can skip to Step 3
3	Complete your Online Application Form for Generic Non-Targeted Funding through the online Funding Portal

What You Will Need!

Besides completing the online registration form you will need to provide documentary evidence outlined in this section when making a funding application with EA

Update or Complete Registration

All core funding will be allocated based on historical funding patterns. Simply put, you will receive the funding you normally get.



Provide your Governance Arrangements

If you do not have a Government Funding Database Number you will need to provide your governance document, e.g. Your Constitution

All Organisations must have a safeguarding policy in place when working with children and young people



Step 1 – Registration with EA

For First Time Registrations or Annual Registration



Benefits of Registration with EA


- Reduced rates at EA Outdoor Learning Centres for activities and overnight stays
- No need to provide additional compliance evidence when applying for relevant funding streams
- Easier Access to additional funding such as T:BUC Camps programme or Planned Intervention



Annual Registration is each Year in April and open all year round to new organisations

How to Register or Reregister



1	Prepare your required documents such as safeguarding policies or governance document you will require for registration	1	Prepare your required documents such as safeguarding policies or governance document you will require for registration
2	Request an Online Account for Our Funding Portal (Visit <u>www.eanifunding.org.uk</u> and select "Register with EA")	2	Log on to your online account (Visit <u>www.eani.smapply.org</u>)
3	Complete the Online Registration Form	3	You will be prompted to update your registration form before you can continue to access the site



What information will I need to provide on the registration form

Form Section	Information Required
Registration Type	You will first be prompted to select your registration type, as this guidance is for Local Voluntary Youth Organisations you will select this option
Organisation Information	You will provide your organisation contact information (where you deliver youth work) and select if applicable or provide the name of a Regional Voluntary Youth Organisation who provides you with support to deliver youth work
Management Committee/Board Membership	Here you will provide the names and email addresses of your Chairperson, Sectary, Treasurer and Leader in Charge (This can also be equivalent of these role for your organisation)
Membership & Staff/Volunteer Information	In this section you will provide breakdown of your current membership by the outlined age bands, and numbers of paid full-time, part-time staff currently funded by EA and volunteers
Safeguarding and Health and Safety Information	A requirement of registration is that all organisations provide their most recent version of their safeguarding policy. You will only need to provide this once unless you update it next year. In addition organisations are required to declare they have appropriate insurance and health and safety practice in place to delivery programmes with children and young people
Confirmation you deliver Youth Work in line with DE Policy and Curriculum	EA Youth Service can only fund and register youth organisations who delivery youth work in line with the Model for Effective Practice and DE Policy Priorities for Youth. Organisations will be required to declare this is the case on their registration form.

New Organistions will receive a Verification Visit from an EA Officer before funding will be awarded





Step 2 – Completing End of Year Report 2021-2022

If currently in receipt of 2021-2022 Generic/Non-Targeted Funding





Annual Report

If your organisation has been in receipt of 2021-2022 funding from the Education Authority for Generic Non-Targeted Funding you will not be able to apply for 2022-2023 funding until you submit your Annual Report through the fund portal.

Once you have complete this report and submitted it, you will be automatically gain access to create a new application for 2022-2023 on the funding portal

Report Section	What will I need to Provide	
Membership Breakdown	Provide the numbers of young people by age band for your registration period of 2021-2022	
Engagement Framework Information	Provide the number of young people per stage on the engagement framework based on your membership	
Actual Funding Used	Provide details of how much of your funding award in 2021-2022 you spent	
Income and Expenditure	Upload a copy of your income and expenditure (Provided with your letter of offer) for the 2021-2022 period	





Step 3 – Completing a 2022-2023 Application




Generic/ Non-Target Application 2022-2023

If you are a newly registered organisation or you have just completed your annual report for 2021-2022, you can select the Generic Non-Targeted funding Stream and start a new Application for 2022-2023 through our funding portal!

Application Section	What will I need to Provide
Main Contact Information	The main contact information who EA will be touch with regarding any queries over your application
Governance Information	If you have a Government Funding Database Number you will provide it here, if not you will be required to up load a copy of your governance document for assessment
Confirm Safeguarding Information	Confirm your safeguarding policy remains the same or upload a revised copy for assessment
Delivery & Membership Information	You will be asked to provide a breakdown of the total number of weeks delivered, total hours of delivery per week, total registered membership and average weekly attendance. This information will be used to assess your funding award.
Bank Account.	If you have already provided this information as part of another application with EA you will only be asked to check it is still correct. New Organisations will be asked to provide this once.

All applications subject to an EA Verification Check and we may visit or contact you to verify the accuracy of information provided on your application form as part of our Audit Process






Application, Assessment & Award Timeline
