WHAT IS A YOUTH TEAM?

- GET ON WELL WITH OTHERS AND LISTEN TO WHAT THEY HAVE TO SAY.
- BE POSITIVE AND HELPFUL.
- BE INTERESTED IN LEARNING MORE ABOUT HOW THEIR GROUP WORKS.
- WANT TO HAVE A SAY IN WHAT SCOUTING LOOKS LIKE.

HOW DOES THE YOUTH TEAM WORK?

- THE YOUTH TEAM SHOULD MEET ONCE EVERY OTHER MONTH TO DISCUSS WHAT SCOUTING LOOKS LIKE IN YOUR GROUP AND SUGGEST THINGS TO DO IN THE FUTURE.
- YOUR YOUTH TEAM WILL CHOOSE A REPRESENTATIVE TO ATTEND A COUNTY YOUTH TEAM EVENT A FEW TIMES ACROSS THE YEAR.
- MEMBERS OF YOUR YOUTH TEAM WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO USE THEIR VOICE TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE FOR OTHERS AND HAVE A SAY IN SHAPING PROJECTS ACROSS THE PROVINCE.
